CALVARY CEMETERY ROCHESTER

GRAVESITE CHANGE OF LOCATION AND BUY BACK POLICY

(Effective August 20, 2012)

It is the policy of Calvary Cemetery Rochester to buy back a gravesite from the rightful owner for the original cost of the gravesite or in exchange for another site.

If the gravesite has a <u>crypt marker</u>, the removal of marker and restoration of the gravesite will be done by cemetery personnel. There is a charge for the removal and restoration. Credit due will be paid to the owner upon removal of marker.

If the gravesite contains an <u>upright monument</u>, it is the responsibility of the rightful owner to remove or make arrangements to remove the monument in a timely manner (2- 4 weeks). Restoration of gravesite will be done by cemetery personnel. There is a charge for the restoration. Credit due will be paid to the owner upon removal of monument.

To verify a change of gravesite location, a new Cemetery Certificate will be issued when removal of the **marker or monument** is completed.

If there is a change of location from a columbarium niche and the niche door is already engraved, the rightful owner is responsible for the cost of a replacement niche door.

If there is a credit due, a donation to the cemetery is appreciated but not required.
